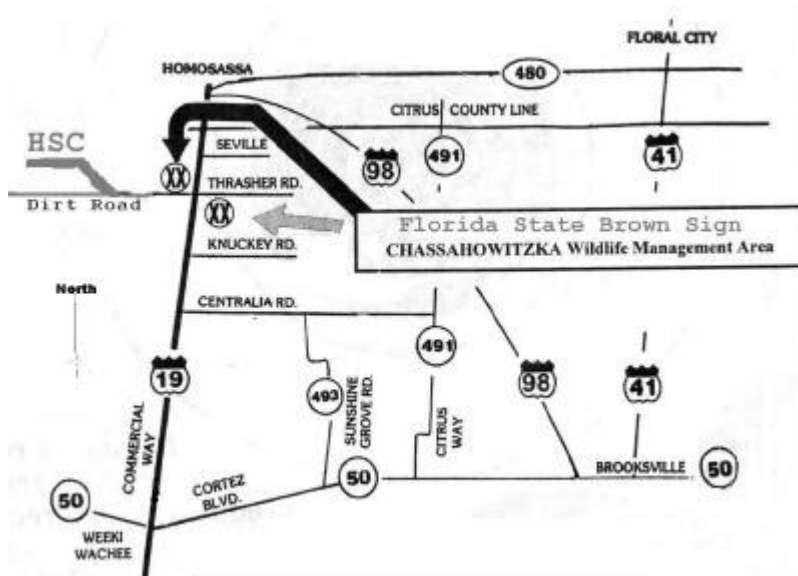


Map

Extra socks & underwear

Uniform for all 3 days– BDU's w/Boots (extra brown tshirts)

Sweatsuit for PT

Sneakers

Warm Jacket

Canteen or Camelback

Flashlight

All Meals/Snacks are provided
